Nomination deadline

September 10, 2019. Qualifying nominations made in 2019 which are not successful may held for future years.

Selection process

An independent committee nominated by PHACS and Rotary will review the nominees and select the award winners. It is not guaranteed that in any particular year awards will be made in all categories.

Award presentation: The awards are presented at a special ceremony at a Pender Harbour Advisory Council or Rotary Club event in the fall of 2018.

All nominees need to have made the contributions for which they are being nominated in the Pender Harbour area and for the benefit of the Pender Harbour area communities.

Lifetime Achievement Award Criteria

Pender Harbour (Area A) Residents who meet the following criteria, are eligible for the Lifetime Achievement Volunteer Award:

- Exemplifies the spirit of community service
- Is a leader and role model
- Breaks new ground
- Supports and encourage the development of others
- Shows vision, initiative and creativity
- Makes a difference
- Is respected for their contributions
- Has a history of volunteer contributions that can be traced back 10 years

Volunteer of the Year Award

Pender Harbour (Area A) Residents who meet the following criteria, are eligible for the Volunteer of the Year Award

- Exemplifies the spirit of community service
- Is a leader and role model
- Breaks new ground
- Supports and encourages the development of others
- Shows vision, initiative and creativity
- Makes a difference
- Is respected for their contributions

Youth Volunteer Award

Pender Harbour (Area A) Residents who meet the following criteria, are eligible for the Youth Volunteer Award :

- Must be no older than 30 years
- Actively participates in community service
- Demonstrates leadership skills and is a role model
- Supports and encourages the development of others
- Demonstrates a passion for their cause or activity
- Makes a difference
- Is respected for their contributions
